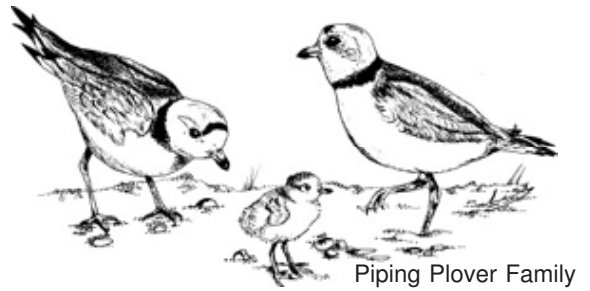

JULY PROGRAMS

Thursday, July 1—Plovers & Terns. Piping plovers returned to the northeast in March, and chicks are already hatching. We'll join Mass Audubon's Coastal Waterbird Program staff to learn the latest about their status.

Tuesday, July 6—*Atlasing Duxbury Beach.* We're in year four of the five-year Breeding Bird Atlas project. John Galluzzo is regional coordinator for Plymouth County and will take us on a reading bird survey of the beach.
